**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Co-ed Coach Pitch** returns for 2022! This “in-town” transitional team for both boys & girls who want to play in a fun-based competitive environment. The team will meet Mon & Wed to practice from 4-5pm & Tues & Thurs to play each other from 4-5pm. We will emphasize sportsmanship; teach basic baseball/softball skills (hitting-throwing-catching-safe sliding & all field positions. During games: Players will rotate field positions and everyone will bat. There will be a 5 inning game or 1 hour (whichever comes first) twice a week designed as follows: 5 pitches thrown total- If no hit after 5 coach pitches then a “T” will be used to guarantee a “hit”. There will be a pitcher & catcher position, 4 Infielders, 4-5 outfielders (depending on attendance) This is designed to be both a fun & learning environment to develop boys & girls who are interested in playing baseball & softball. The coaches may choose to alter the game schedule to more than one time per week. We are in need of coaching assistance & will provide training tools and schedules to aide you in doing so. Please call the office with any questions.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Baseball & Softball** program will play at least two games a week both home & away on Tuesday & Thursday nights. They will be playing in a league with 5 other towns (Sheldon, Sibley, Hull, Rock Rapids & Larchwood.) They will meet to practice on non-game days at the Sports Complex at the times listed above on Monday-Thursday. **The season will start before June 1<sup>st</sup>**... A complete schedule will be provided to you and will also be available online once the registration process is complete. We are looking for coaching assistance for all grade levels.

# **ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS**

## **Girls/Boys Basketball**

### Sessions:

- Girls Basketball: 9:00 – 9:50am (Grades 3-8) – Monday thru Thursday
- Boys Basketball: 10:00 – 10:50am (Grades 3-8) – Monday thru Thursday
- Location: City Basketball Courts (15<sup>th</sup> St.)
  - In the event of inclement weather or wet courts, the location will be moved to the ROCK VALLEY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL GYMNASIUM.

### Description:

Participants will learn the basics of the game of basketball: dribbling, passing, shooting, defense, setting screens, etc. Games of pick-up basketball, 3 on 3, knock-out and HORSE, among others, will be played.

## **Engineering**
